

Mr. Shenot:

I must apologize but due to illness and a down computer I have not been able to respond to your investigation as I would like to. However, I would like to make several quick comments in regard to the questions posed in the "Investigation":

1. An ART should be for the purposes of:
 - a. To accelerate the installations, as this will aid in bringing down CAPEX, and
 - b. Reduce Greenhouse Gas Emissions
2. In personal meetings with the Utilities, I have found them very willing to pay a premium for electricity from biogas given a Capacity Factor of 85% or more. That being said, I believe a significant premium scale should be developed for Capacity hurdles of 85%, 87.5%, 90%, & 93%. I believe the premium should be an annual or semi-annual premium not a monthly premium. I think that the ART for each fee should be near 12.5¢, 13.75¢, 15.0¢, and 17.75¢, respectively. This would not only assist in the promotion of viable technologies, but would have a strong pull towards the best in class technology (ies).
3. A question was posed about varying types of technologies: I would encourage PSC to review the achievements of Sweden, as it is a geographic and demographic not so far afield of Wisconsin and they have made some significant achievements. Please review this graphic:

Sweden is a role model of how a democratic state can gradually make a transition away from imported oil to biomass based renewable energy sources in a free market economy. Sweden anticipates being completely independent of oil by 2020.

It should be further noted that Biomass significantly out paced Hydro-electric advances.
